

Route 7: South Norway - to Kvinnherad (with 2012 prices):

From South (the coastal road): Kristiansand – Stavanger - Ranavik

- Follow E-39 north towards Bergen (toll charged road), through Stavanger (13 NOK toll – Autopass). **Drive through without stopping.** (* see info below).
- Drive through the Rennfast tunnel (no toll) and reach Mortavika ferry port.
- Take the ferry to Arsvågen. The trip costs about 171 NOK for a car with driver, and 37 NOK per adult (if retired = retired instructions!).
- Continue in the direction of Bergen on E-39. In Våg there is another automatic toll booth (12 NOK Autopass). Continue towards Stord, drive through the Bømlafjord-tunnel (85 NOK toll - in cash or Autopass) and reach the isle of Stord. Keep driving on E-39 towards Bergen to the sign „Ranavik 544“ and leave the main road to the right.
- Make a right turn in the first roundabout and drive towards the marked ferry. On Skjersholmane ferry harbour position yourself on the track to **Ranavik**. The trip costs about 133 NOK for 1 car with driver, and 44 NOK per adult.

Note. Alternative route to Skånevik and ferry to Utåker:

In Aksdal drive on E-134 towards Oslo. Pass through Ølen and Etne. Continue to Håland and look for the signs to Skånevik and road 48, over the small mountain pass to the ferry port. Position yourself on the track to Utåker. *Please study the timetables; this ferry makes trips until 22:00 PM.*

From North: Bergen - Årsnes

- Follow E-39 south towards Stavanger, and reach Nestun (toll charged road). Further on road 580 to Indre Arna.
- Follow E-16 towards Voss, and to Trengereid. Leave the road and continue on road 7 to Tysse.
- In Tysse continue on road 48, through Eikelandsosen, Mundheim and reach Gjermundshavn.
- Ferry Gjermundshavn – Årsnes. The trip costs about 102 NOK for 1 car with driver, and 37 NOK per adult.

From East: Oslo – Larvik – East Norway and Kristiansand (the mountain road)

- From Oslo, Larvik and Kristiansand drive on E-134, crossing Haukeli, towards Haugesund (toll charged road).
- Drive to Skare (passed Røldal) and continue on road 13 to Odda, and drive through the **Følgefontunnel**, about 12 km long, towards Rosendal. (Toll 72 NOK Autopass). **Drive through without stopping.** (* see info below).

* Info regarding fully automatic toll booths.

Drive through without stopping! How to pay:

1. *With AutoPASS electronic tag.* Contract and electronic tag is available at the Servicestations.

(for people who often pass toll stations).

2. *Without an AutoPASS electronic tag.* If you don't have an AutoPASS or a [Visitors' Payment contract](#), the invoice is sent to the vehicle owner by standard mail. This invoice is sent from Euro Parking Collection (EPC) plc in London, United Kingdom. It can take up to six months before this invoice is sent.

3. *Pay at the Servicestation.* You can also pay the toll fee at facilities, such as petrol stations close to the toll station, within three working days (after passing the toll point). Look for the sign: “Kr-service”.
